**Introduction:** Our Heritage is published bi-annually (January & July) by the Sanskrit College and University. It accepts scholarly contributions in Sanskrit, Pali, Bengali and English and publishes quality articles on any aspects of Indology covering:

- The different cultural aspects of Indology;

- Theoretical, practical, and methodological issues;
- Textual, linguistics, archaeological, and historical studies and inter- disciplinary approaches to the subject.
- Sanskrit Computation Linguistics.

**Guidelines for publication:**

- Articles are normally to be 4000-8000 words in length, should be accompanied by a bibliography and references and may be accompanied by end notes and key words.
- Any quotation used in the article is expected to be identical with the original. For all copy –right materials the author should seek and have the permission from appropriate authorities.
- Manuscripts in duplicate prepared in accordance with the standard of international guidelines for publication should be sent to the general editor.

**Technical details:**

**Format:** MS Word

**Font:** Times New Roman for English, Sansrit 2003 for Sanskrit, Shonar Bangla for Bengali. Charis SIL for diacritical marks.

**Size:** 12 points.

**Line space:** Double.

**Margins:** one inch margins on single sided A4 paper.

**Format for Bibliography:**

**1. For book-**

Title of the author, First name of the author. *Book name*. City: Publisher, Year of Publication. Print.

**Example:** Vattanky, John S.J. *Nyāya Philosophy of Language*. Delhi: Sri Satguru Publications, 1995 (Sri Garib Das Oriental Series No. 187).

**2. For paper in a journal-**

Title of the author, First name of the author. "Article Title". *Journal Title*. Series, Volume. Issue (Year of Publication): page(s).

**Example:** Matilal, Bimal Krishna, 'Indian Theories of Knowledge and Truth', *Philosophy East and West*, Vol. 18, Honolulu: 1968, pp. 321-334.

**For edited book:**

Title of the author, First name of the author. *Book name*. Ed. Editor's name. City: Publisher, Year of Publication.

**Example:** Jagannatha. *Rasagāṅgādhara*. Ed. Sandhya Bhanduri. Calcutta: The Asiatic Society, 1992.

**Structure of the paper:** The structure of the paper as follows:

1. Title, 2. Author(s) name with affiliation, email Id and contact no. 3. Abstract, 4. Key words, 5. Main body, 6. Conclusion, 7. Endnote, 8. Bibliography.

One hardcopy of the paper has to be submitted to the office of the editor in the department of Sanskrit, The Sanskrit College and University.
